

This primary school aged course will allow bright students to develop an understanding of aviation and associated experiences by linking in with the Aviation Specialist course at Melville Senior High School. The Aviation course incorporates a variety of Aviation subjects that not only relate to industry directly but also enhance the scientific learning of students who are gifted science students. The course numbers are limited to 25 so enrol early.

The opportunity to enable primary school students to experience Aviation in their early years can foster enthusiasm for success in the upper school Aviation course. The intention of the program is to give students a hands on approach to Aviation through actual flight in an aircraft and completion of exercises on the flight simulators.

The 'Come Fly with Me" course has been very popular with primary students; students have liked the course so much that they often repeat it. Not only do participating students look at a range of areas in Aviation from history to aerodynamics, they also get time to learn to fly an aircraft on the flight simulators at the school. Many students have become excellent flight simulator pilots because of their great handling skills.

The course is taught at Melville Senior High School's Specialist Aviation Centre by Mr Randall Brink, the schools own qualified flight instructor. Mr Brink states "the students are always keen to learn as much as possible about flight and they also learn to fly using the flight sims. Their flight in a real is a fantastic experience for them and they don't stop talking about it for weeks'.

The culmination of the eight week course is a flight in a real aircraft where some students whohave the opportunity sit in the front next to the pilot, are able to take the controls and fly a real aircraft with the assistance of a qualified flying instructor. It is encouraging to see primary students excel in this area of knowledge and many graduates of the program have gone on to apply and be accepted, into the Aviation Studies Specialist course at Melville Senior High School.
