The School Board has established a uniform for all students attending the school. The school believes a uniform helps to:

- Promote equality
- Promote self esteem
- Enhance self and school image

Modification of Dress Code Items

Students who for religious or health reasons may need to modify the school uniform are required to make an appointment with one of the Managers in Student Services. Staff will be informed of any student granted a modification to the uniform.

Uniform shop opening hours:

Compulsory Uniform for all Years

Shirt	MSHS plain white, buttoned, collared shirt with school logo. Students may wear a white undershirt.
Skirt	MSHS black skirt or shorts with MSHS logo (no generic alternatives) (Not longer than mid calf or shorter than mid thigh)
Shorts/Pants	MSHS black pants or shorts with MSHS logo (no generic alternatives)
School Top	MSHS jacket - zipped, green, white and black with school logo or MSHS bottle green woollen jumper or MSHS leavers jacket - black and white with school logo (option for years 11 and 12)
Scarf (optional)	MSHS black or green with school logo
Physical Education	MSHS Bottle green polo shirt with gold and white stripe (not to be worn at other times) MSHS Black micro fibre shorts or tracksuit pants with MSHS logo

All above items are only available from the Melville SHS Uniform Shop

Footwear will be closed in shoes only with no thongs, slides or ugg boots.

All clothing is to be clean and neat and worn appropriately.

Excessive make up or jewellery is not allowed.

Official Melville Senior High School white shirts with white undershirts only are allowed.

Official MSHS Black pants, shorts or skirts only are allowed.

Leggings are only to be worn under skirt or shorts.

Students must change before and after physical activities. Hats and sunscreen should be worn when in outdoor activities. After vigorous activities students should shower.

All students may be requested to return home to change if out of correct uniform or parents may be contacted to bring the appropriate uniform to school.
